In the past, various online information service systems for use by students and teachers were built, including the Online Course-registration System and the Keio Researchers Information System. However, to utilize these services, users had to use different user IDs (account name, login name, and so on) and passwords.

Keio.jp is intended to be the first step toward constructing an information infrastructure as part of an integrated IT environment, where users can utilize services in a more secure, speedy, and robust manner.

- 2. Enter the activation key printed after "Your Activation Key" on the reverse side of this letter, an account name of your choice, a password, and your birth date; and then click [OK].
- 3. When the Issuance Complete message is displayed by the system, your activation is complete.
- \*Your activation key is a string of characters that identifies you and acts as a password with which you can obtain your Keio ID.
- \*The activation key expires on March 31, 2006. Please note that after this date, your activation key must be reissued.
- \*Please store this notice in a safe place.
- \*When you leave Keio University, your Keio ID might become invalid. In that case, you will not be able to use the services on the system. For more details, contact us using the contact info given below.

· Corporate bulletin board

You can view various notices and messages from the administrative section.

· Keio mail

This is a new email system that you can access from a web browser or mobile phone.

- \*You can use your Keio ID as your email account.
- \*A Keio email account will be provided as a new email address. You can also continue using your existing email addresses.
- Education Support System (trial operation is scheduled to start in November)

  This is a system for distributing course materials to students, operating a bulletin board for each course, and accepting student essays and term papers.
- Rental Status Check Service (operated by the Media Center: scheduled to start in December)

You can check the status of the books you have borrowed from the Media Center.

• Registration of Research Achievements Database (operated by the Office of Research Administration: scheduled to start in November) You can register data in the Research Achievements Database using your Keio ID.
